Riverside Community College District Bond Measure: Not yet named – Riverside Community College District Career Preparation, Affordable Higher Education Measure – To repair/upgrade local community colleges, improve access to affordable higher education for careers/university transfer; provide safe drinking water; remove asbestos, lead paint; repair deteriorating gas lines, roofs; upgrade safety/security; and acquire, construct, repair facilities, sites, equipment; shall Riverside Community College District's measure authorizing \$954,000,000 in bonds at legal rates (levying (split sample C: \$19 per \$100,00) (split sample D: \$0.02 per \$100) of assessed valuation (\$57,000,000 annually while bonds are outstanding) with oversight and audits.

Proposition 2: Yes - \$10 Billion school facilities construction bond

Proposition 3: Yes - Replace ban on same-sex marriage in Constitution

Proposition 4: Yes - \$10 Billion Climate Resiliency Bond

Proposition 5: Yes - Lowers vote threshold to approve local bonds

Proposition 6: Yes - Prohibits mandatory prison labor

Proposition 32: Yes - \$18/hr. minimum wage
